





## **2010 POLICING AND LAW ENFORCEMENT ADVISORY PANEL ORDER**

### **Esquimalt Policing and Law Enforcement Advisory Panel**

- 1 (1) The Esquimalt Policing and Law Enforcement Advisory Panel (the "panel") is established consisting of the following individuals:
  - (a) the mayor of the Township of Esquimalt;
  - (b) one individual designated by the council of the Township of Esquimalt;
  - (c) not more than three individuals designated by the Minister of Public Safety and Solicitor General.
- (2) The Minister of Public Safety and Solicitor General requests that the panel
  - (a) review policing and law enforcement in the Township of Esquimalt,
  - (b) report to the Minister of Public Safety and Solicitor General and the Director of Police Services, Ministry of Public Safety and Solicitor General, on the subject of the review under paragraph (a), and
  - (c) make recommendations, if any, to the Minister of Public Safety and Solicitor General and the Director of Police Services, Ministry of Public Safety and Solicitor General, respecting
    - (i) the subject of review under paragraph (a), and
    - (ii) what the panel considers necessary to meet the requirements of section 15 of the *Police Act* as it relates to the Township of Esquimalt.
