

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT

BY-LAW NO. 106

WHEREAS the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt desires and intends to make or extend the road or street in the said Township of Esquimalt known and described as Constance Avenue across or through the piece or pieces of land in Esquimalt District in the Province of British Columbia more particularly known and described as follows:

Lots Three (3) and Four (4), Subdivision of Suburban Lot Fifty-One (51), Map Sixty-One (61), Esquimalt District:

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt enacts as follows:

1. The Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt shall acquire the portion or portions of the above recited Lots Three (3) and Four (4) necessary or required for the above recited making or extension of Constance Avenue through such lots.
2. It shall be lawful for the Reeve and Clerk of the Municipal Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt, and they are hereby authorized and directed, to enter into negotiations with the owner or owners of the said recited lots Three (3) and Four (4) and all and any persons interested therein for the purpose of purchasing, acquiring or accepting such portion or portions of the above recited Lots Three (3) and Four (4) necessary or required for the above recited making or extension of Constance Avenue through such Lots.
3. The said Reeve and Municipal Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to enter into and execute and deliver such agreement or agreements or other instruments as may be necessary to acquire such portion or portions of the above recited Lots Three (3) and Four (4) necessary or required for the above recited making or extension of Constance Avenue through such Lots.
4. The said Reeve and Municipal Clerk are hereby authorized to do all such acts and things as may be necessary for the purchasing, acquiring or accepting and, if necessary, the expropriating of such portion or portions of the above recited Lots Three (3) and Four (4) necessary or required for the above recited making or extension of Constance Avenue through such Lots.

This By-Law may be cited as "The Constance Avenue Right-of-Way, Acquiring and Expropriating By-Law."

PASSED the Municipal Council the 29th day of November, 1920.
