

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT

BY-LAW NO. 109

A By-law to abolish the Ward System within the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt.

WHEREAS at the last Annual Election for Reeve and Councillors for the Township of Esquimalt the opinion of the Municipal Electors of the said Municipality was obtained pursuant to Sub-section 164 of Section 54 of the "Municipal Act" and pursuant to "The Referendum By-law", upon the question whether the ward system should be abolished and the Councillors elected from the city at large and the said question was answered in the affirmative:

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt enacts as follows:

1. All wards within the Township of Esquimalt are hereby declared to be abolished, and the division of the Municipality of Esquimalt into wards shall hereafter be discontinued. The Councillors for the Township of Esquimalt, to wit, six in number, shall be elected from the Township of Esquimalt at large and nothing herein contained shall affect the standing of any member of the Council now or hereafter to be elected for the present existing municipal year.
2. By-law No. 12 is hereby repealed, subject, however, to the provisions as aforesaid respecting the standing of members of the Council for the present existing municipal year.
3. This By-law may be cited as the "WARDS ABOLITION BY-LAW" 1921.

PASSED the Municipal Council the thirty-first day of January, 1921.

RECONSIDERED, ADOPTED AND FINALLY PASSED the Municipal Council the 14th day of February, 1921.
