

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT

BY-LAW NO. 115

WHEREAS the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt desires and intends to make or extend the road or street in the said Township of Esquimalt known and described as Grafton Street across or through that piece or parcel of land in Esquimalt District more particularly known and described as follows:

Suburban Lot 27, Map 10A, Esquimalt District,

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt enacts as follows:

1. The Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt shall for the purpose aforesaid acquire that part or portion of the said Suburban Lot 27 known and described as follows: All that parcel of land being part of Suburban Lot 27, Esquimalt District in the Province of British Columbia, and being the Westerly thirty (30) feet of that part of the said Suburban Lot lying to the South of the New Esquimalt Road. The whole containing 0.248 acres more or less, and being shown coloured red on the plans hereto attached.
2. It shall be lawful for the Reeve and Clerk of the Municipal Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt and they are hereby authorized and directed to enter into negotiations with the owner or owners of the said recited Suburban Lot 27 and all and any persons interested therein for the purpose of purchasing, acquiring or accepting the said part or portion of the said Suburban Lot 27 in the preceding paragraph hereof mentioned.
3. The said Reeve and Municipal Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to enter into and execute and deliver such agreement or agreements or other instruments as may be necessary to acquire the aforementioned part or portion of the said Suburban Lot 27.
4. The said Reeve and Municipal Clerk are hereby authorized to do all such acts and things as may be necessary for the purchasing, acquiring or accepting and if necessary, the expropriating of the aforementioned part or portion of said Suburban Lot 27.

This By-Law may be cited as "The Grafton Street Extension Purchase By-Law, 1921".

PASSED the Municipal Council the 25th day of April, 1921.
