

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT

BY-LAW NO. 1197

BEING a By-law of the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt for the purpose of stopping and closing to traffic a portion of the public highway known as Dominion Road for the purpose of vesting title to it in the British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority.

WHEREAS there exists in the Municipality of Esquimalt a highway known as "Dominion Road".

AND WHEREAS a portion of the said road has never had any money expended on it nor has been constructed as a highway.

AND WHEREAS the adjoining owners of the said portion of Dominion Road have consented to the closure and abandonment of that portion of Dominion Road for the purpose of vesting title to it in the British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That that certain portion of the highway known as "Dominion Road" in the Municipality of Esquimalt, being more particularly described as:

All that part of the public highway known as Dominion Road, commencing at the North East corner of Parcel "A" of Lot One (1) in Block "F" of Section Ten (10), Esquimalt District, Plan 195-C thence North $88^{\circ} 35' 20''$ East a distance of 30.67', thence South $10^{\circ} 34' 40''$ West a distance of 95.00', to the North West corner of S.L. 16 Plan 296, thence South $73^{\circ} 45'$ West a distance of 33.62' to the South East corner of said Parcel "A" of Lot One (1), Section Ten (10), Esquimalt District. Thence North $10^{\circ} 34' 40''$ East along the Easterly boundary of said Parcel "A" of Lot One (1) a distance of 103.80' to the point of commencement,

be and the same is hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.

2. A plan of the said part of the public highway known as Dominion Road is attached hereto as part of this By-law.
3. This By-law shall take effect upon the adoption thereof.
4. This By-law may be cited as the "Portion of Dominion Road Closing By-law, 1967".
