

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT

BY-LAW NO. 1439

BEING a By-law for the purpose of stopping and closing to traffic a portion of the highway known as Barton Road.

WHEREAS there exists in the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt a highway known as "Barton Road";

AND WHEREAS the Municipality no longer requires a certain portion said Barton Road, hereinafter described to be used for the purpose of a highway and it is deemed expedient to stop up and close to traffic that portion of the said Barton Road more particularly hereinafter described;

AND WHEREAS the owners of lands adjoining the said portion of Barton Road herein referred to have consented to the closure of the said portion of Barton Road by the Municipality;

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That certain portion of the highway known as "Barton Road" in the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt being more particularly described as:


That part of Barton Road shown as Viewfield Avenue on Plan 768 bounded on the southwest by the north-east boundary of Esquimalt Road on the northeast by a straight line joining the northeast corner of Lot 2 to the northwest corner of Lot 11 of said Plan 768.


be and the same is hereby stopped and closed to traffic.
