

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT

BY-LAW NO. 1456

BEING a By-law to ratify an agreement.


WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt has on the 9th day of October, 1973 entered into an agreement with Her Majesty the Queen, represented by the Minister of Highways for the Province of British Columbia, whereby that portion of Tillicum Road commencing at the north boundary of the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt, thence in a generally southerly direction to the intersection with Craigflower Road, a total distance of 0.33 mile, more or less, shall be classified as a Secondary Highway.


NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That the agreement dated the 9th day of October, 1973 between the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt and Her Majesty the Queen, represented by the Minister of Highways for the Province of British Columbia is hereby ratified in accordance with the provisions of Sections 31 and 32 of the "Highway Act".
2. That the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt is hereby authorized to do all acts and things requisite and necessary to carry out the provisions of the aforesaid agreement.
3. This By-law may be cited as the "Tillicum Road Secondary Highway Classification Agreement Ratification By-law, 1973".
