CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT

BY-LAW NO. 1778

BEING a By-law to authorize temporary borrowings pending the sale of debentures.

WHEREAS it is provided by Section 342 of the "Municipal Act" that the Council may, where it has adopted a loan authorization by-law, without further assents or approvals, borrow temporarily from any person under the conditions therein set out;

AND WHEREAS the Council has adopted By-law No. 1773, cited as the "Library Building Loan Authorization By-law, 1984" authorizing the construction of a library building and borrowing in the amount of Two Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$225,000.00);

AND WHEREAS the sale of the said debentures has been temporarily deferred;

NOW, THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Council is hereby authorized and empowered to borrow temporarily an amount or amounts not exceeding the sum of Two Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$225,000.00), as the same may be required at an interest rate not exceeding that approved by the Inspector of Municipalities.
- 2. The form of obligation to be given as acknowledgement of the liability shall be a promissory note or notes bearing the corporate seal and signed by the Mayor and Treasurer.
- 3. The money so borrowed shall be used solely for the purposes set out in the said By-law No. 1773.
- 4. The proceeds from the sale of the debentures, or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be used to repay the money so borrowed.
- 5. This By-law may be cited as the "LIBRARY BUILDING BORROWING BY-LAW, 1984".
