

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT

BY-LAW NO. 181

By-Law to widen that portion of Grafton Street from Lyall Street to Esquimalt Road.

WHEREAS that part of Grafton Street lying between the north boundary of Lyall Street and the south boundary of The New Esquimalt Road, is thirty (30') feet in width:

AND WHEREAS the lands and premises contiguous to the westerly boundary of the said portion of Grafton Street above referred to and being Lot Eight (8), Subdivision of Lot Twenty-six (26) of Composite Plan 2539, Esquimalt District, is owned by the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt:

AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary and expedient to widen the said portion of Grafton Street by having the ~~easterly~~ Thirty (30') feet of Lot Eight (8) as aforesaid, reserved for highway purposes thereby widening the above described portion of Grafton Street.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt enacts as follows:

1. That the easterly Thirty (30') feet of said Lot Eight (8) subdivision of Lot Twenty-six (26) of Composite Plan 2538 be set aside for the purpose of widening that portion of Grafton Street lying between the north boundary of Lyall Street and the south boundary of the New Esquimalt Road and is dedicated for the public use as a highway:
2. This By-Law may be cited as the "Grafton Street Widening By-Law" No. 181.

PASSED the Municipal Council on the 5th day of December, 1927.

RECONSIDERED, ADOPTED AND FINALLY PASSED the Municipal Council on the 19th day of December, 1927.
