

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT

BY-LAW NO. 182

A By-Law to provide for the acceptance and maintenance of the War Memorial situate in the grounds of the Memorial Park, in the Township of Esquimalt:

WHEREAS, the Esquimalt War Memorial Committee was duly constituted, for the purpose of raising funds for the erection and construction of a suitable Memorial for former residents of the Municipality of the Township of Esquimalt who lost their lives as a result of the late European War, 1914 - 1918.

AND WHEREAS a fitting Memorial has been constructed and completed in the grounds of the Memorial Park. Esquimalt aforesaid, and all accounts for labor and material in connection with the construction of the same have been duly paid and discharged for by the said Committee, and the said Committee has appeared before the Municipal Council of Esquimalt and application that the liability for the future maintenance, conduct and up-keep of the said War Memorial be conferred in, assumed and taken over by the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt:

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Township of Esquimalt, enacts as follows:

1. The up-keep and maintenance of the War Memorial situate in the grounds of the Memorial Park, Esquimalt, British Columbia, shall be vested, as and from the date hereof, exclusively in the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt in perpetual succession.
2. All proper or necessary repairs for the maintenance and upkeep of the said Memorial and grounds pertaining thereto, shall be, as and from the date hereof, controlled, undertaken and paid for, by the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt forever hereafter in perpetuity.
3. This By-Law may be cited as the "War Memorial By-Law, No. 182."

PASSED the Municipal Council on the 19th day of January, 1928.

RECONSIDERED, ADOPTED AND FINALLY PASSED the Municipal Council on the 30th day of January, 1928.
