

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT

BY-LAW NO. 193

A By-Law to authorize the closing and vesting of an unused public road adjoining Lots 9 and 15, Block A as shown on registered subdivision Plan 195, deposited in the Land Registry Office at Victoria, British Columbia.

WHEREAS that portion of Tillicum Road contiguous to Lots 9 and 15, Block A, Map 195, Esquimalt District, was not laid out or constructed according to its location as shown on said map.

AND WHEREAS the proper location of the said Tillicum Road in the area aforesaid has been definitely established by notice in the British Columbia Gazette on the 9th of November, 1928.

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt enacts as follows:

1. That the unused portion of Tillicum Road to the west of Lots 9 and 15, Block A, as shown on registered plan 195, from the northerly boundary of Craigflower Road to the Easterly boundary of Tillicum Road as established by Notice in the British Columbia Gazette on the 8th day of November 1928, registered plan 170 R. W., being referred to therein, be abandoned and the area so abandoned be vested in the owners of the lands contiguous to the said unused portion of Tillicum Road.
2. The Reeve and Clerk of the Municipal Council are hereby authorized to execute all documents and to do and execute all necessary acts and things for putting the purposes of this By-Law in execution.
3. This By-Law may be cited as the "Tillicum Road" abandonment By-Law, 1928."

PASSED the Municipal Council this 10th day of December, 1928.

RECONSIDERED, ADOPTED AND FINALLY PASSED by the Municipal Council this 17th day of December, 1928.
