

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT

BYLAW NO. 1939

A Bylaw to designate the school building
at 670 Lampson Street as a Heritage
site.

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the "HERITAGE DESIGNATION BYLAW (670 LAMPSON STREET), 1990, NO. 1939".
2. The school building being part of the premises commonly known as 670 Lampson Street and situate in that certain piece or parcel of land or lands and premises lying, being and situate in the Township of Esquimalt in the Province of British Columbia and described as Lot 16, Block 4, Section 11, Esquimalt District, Plan 195, except that part thereof included within the boundaries of Plan 33469, is hereby designated as a "Municipal Heritage Site" pursuant to Section 11 of the "Heritage Conservation Act", R.S.B.C. 1979, c. 165.
3. No grant, loan, tax relief or other compensation shall be made, given or granted to the owner or owners of the aforesaid building by reason or on account of any loss or damage suffered by the said owner or owners as a result of the designation effected by the Bylaw.
4. No person shall:
 - (a) demolish the building; or
 - (b) alter the facade or exterior of the building; designated under this Bylaw without the prior approval, by resolution, of the Council.


