#### CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT

#### **BYLAW NO. 2619**

A Bylaw to authorise the use of the Municipal Ticketing Information System.

WHEREAS Section 260(1) of the *Community Charter* empowers the Council to make bylaws for the purposes of enforcing the bylaws of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS Section 264 of the *Community Charter* empowers Council to ticket for bylaw offences;

AND WHEREAS the *Community Charter* empowers the Council to, by bylaw, designate those bylaws for which the municipal ticket information may be used as a means of bylaw enforcement;

AND WHEREAS the *Community Charter* empowers the Council to designate as a bylaw enforcement officer the person who comes within a class of persons prescribed by regulation;

AND WHEREAS the Council deems it expedient to authorise the use of the municipal ticket information for the enforcement of certain bylaws, to authorise the use of certain words or expressions to designate certain offences against a bylaw and to set certain fine amounts.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited as the "TICKET INFORMATION UTILIZATION BYLAW, 2005, NO. 2619."
- 2. The bylaws listed in Column 1 of Schedule "A" of this Bylaw, may be enforced by means of a ticket in the form prescribed for the purpose of Section 260 of the *Community Charter.*
- 3. The persons appointed to the job positions or titles listed in Column 2 of Schedule "A" to this Bylaw are designated as bylaw enforcement officers for the purpose of

enforcing the bylaws listed in Column 1 of Schedule "A" opposite the respective job positions.

- 4. The words or expressions set forth in Column 1 of Schedules "B 1" through "B 13" to this Bylaw designate the offences committed under the bylaw section numbers appearing in Column 2 of Schedules "B 1" through "B 13" opposite the respective words or expressions.
- 5. The amounts appearing in Column 3 of Schedules "B 1" through "B 13" to this Bylaw are the fines for contravention of the Bylaw offences set out in column 1, Schedules "B 1" to "B 13".
- 6. Not withstanding Section 5, the Full fines for parking infractions listed in Schedule "B 9" from "No Stopping Zones, Section 15, through to "Bus Parking, Section 42 inclusive, may be reduced by 50% if paid within 14 days of the ticket being issued.
- 7. Severability

If any section, subsection, clause or other provision of this bylaw is for any reason held to be invalid by the decision of a court of competent jurisdiction, the decision does not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this bylaw.

8. Repeal Bylaw No. 2333 and all the amendments thereto are hereby repealed.
