

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT

BYLAW NO. 2036

A Bylaw to reserve certain lands for park purposes (Phil Ross Park).

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 532 of the "Municipal Act" the Council of a Municipality may by bylaw reserve for a particular municipal or other public purpose any land owned by the Municipality;

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the "PARK RESERVATION (PHIL ROSS PARK) BYLAW, 1992, NO. 2036".

2. That the following lands be and hereby are reserved for the purpose of a public park:

That portion of closed road Section 11, Esquimalt District, Plan VIP 52502 shown in heavy black outline on Schedule "A" attached hereto.
