

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT

BY-LAW NO. 217

A By-Law establishing certain lands as a street and extending Woolwich Street southerly to High Water mark.

WHEREAS the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt, is seized in possession in fee simple of the lands and premises known as part of Block "F", suburban Lot Twenty-three (23), Esquimalt District registered in the Land Registry Office at Victoria, British Columbia, under number 60980-I.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to extend Woolwich Street southerly to give access to tidewater.

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt therefore enacts as follows:

1. The land above described and being that part of said Block "F", lying to the East of the West line of Woolwich Street produced, the southern boundary of which abuts on high water mark, is opened, established and dedicated as a public highway, and hereafter to form part of and be known and designated Woolwich Street.
2. This By-Law may be cited as the "Woolwich Street Extension By-Law".

PASSED the Municipal Council on the 11th day of April, 1932.

RECONSIDERED, ADOPTED AND FINALLY PASSED the Municipal Council this 25th day of April, 1932.
