

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT

BY-LAW NO. 218

BEING a By-law renaming part of "Old Esquimalt Road" as "Park Terrace".

WHEREAS the residents of premises on the Old Esquimalt Road from the eastern boundary of Grenville Avenue, easterly to the eastern boundary of the Memorial Park, have requested the Municipal Council to change the name of the said road as to the part mentioned to "Park Terrace".

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council has power by By-law duly passed by a vote of three-fourths of the whole Council to alter the name of any street or public thoroughfare.

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt therefore unanimously enact that:

1. The name of "Old Esquimalt Road" between the limits of said road mentioned in the first recital of this By-law be altered and changed and hereafter be known and designated "Park Terrace" and the numbering of houses and lots abutting on said portion of the road to remain as before the passing of this By-law.
2. This By-law may be cited as "PARK TERRACE RENAMING BY-LAW".

Passed the Municipal Council on the 11th day of April, 1932.
