CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT

BY-LAW NO. 322

BEING a By-law exempting from the 1940 Tax Sale lands of a disabled soldier.

WHEREAS one Lawrence Quarmby a soldier within the meaning of the "Allied Forces Exemption Act" 1918 is the owner of lands and premises known as Lot 3, Esquimalt District, Map 2856 and the building thereon is used by the said Lawrence Quarmby as his residence and that of his family.

AND WHEREAS the said Lawrence Quarmby is at present suffering from a mental disorder and the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt in pursuance of its powers in that behalf is willing to extend the period of payment of delinquent taxes now amounting to the sum of \$79.18.

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt therefore enacts as follows:

- 1. The lands and premises known as Lot 3, Esquimalt District, Map 2856 be withheld and exempt from the annual tax sale for the year 1940.
- 2. The exemption of said lands and premises from the 1940 tax sale shall not operate to relieve the said lands and premises from any taxes lawfully imposed or to prejudice the right of the Collector of the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt, to offer the same for sale in any succeeding year.
- 3. This By-law may be cited as the "Quarmby Tax Sale 1940 Exemption By-law".

PASSED the Municipal Council on the 20th day of August, 1940.

RECONSIDERED, ADOPTED AND FINALLY PASSED the Municipal Council this 3rd day of September, 1940.
