

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT

BY-LAW NO. 349

BEING a By-law to provide for the abatement of delinquent taxes imposed on property owned by a disabled soldier.

WHEREAS one Lawrence Quarmby, a soldier within the meaning of the "Allied Forces Exemption Act" 1918, is the owner of lands and premises known as Lot 3, Esquimalt District, Map 2856 and the building thereon is used by the said Lawrence Quarmby as his residence and that of his family.

AND WHEREAS the said Lawrence Quarmby is at present suffering from a mental disorder resulting in complete disability and the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt in pursuance of its powers in that behalf is desirous of abating the delinquent taxes now due and payable in respect of such lands and premises hereinbefore and hereinafter particularly described.

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt therefore enacts as follows:

1. That the delinquent taxes now due and owing in respect of the lands and premises known as Lot 3, Esquimalt District, Map 2856 be wholly abated.
2. This By-law may be cited as the "QUARMBY TAX ABATEMENT BY-LAW, 1942".

PASSED the Municipal Council on the 29th day of June, 1942.

RECONSIDERED, ADOPTED and FINALLY PASSED the Municipal Council this 6th day of July, 1942.
