

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT

BY-LAW NO. 375

BEING a by-law to set aside certain lands
for school purposes.

WHEREAS the lands and premises hereinafter particularly described have become the property of the Corporation through Tax Sale proceedings, and a By-law to set aside such lands for the purposes mentioned herein does not require the assent of the electors of the said Corporation.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that such lands be set aside for school purposes.

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt enacts as follows:

1. The lands and premises above referred to and described as follows: Lot four (4) Map 3659, Esquimalt District, described and embraced in Certificate of Title 101848-I, and Lot ten (10), in Block two (2) of Section eleven (11), Esquimalt District Plan 195, described and embraced in Certificate of Title Numbers 57692-I and 98083-I, be set aside, dedicated, used and held as a school site and for school purposes.
2. This By-law may be cited as the "ESQUIMALT HIGH SCHOOL LAND DEDICATION BY-LAW".

PASSED by the Municipal Council on 2nd day of October, 1944.
