

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT

BY-LAW NO. 430

BEING a by-law to provide for Daylight Saving Time, for the period of 28th of April 1946 to the 28th September 1946, inclusive, in the Municipality of Esquimalt.

WHEREAS under and by virtue of enabling statutory authority in that behalf, the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt on the 25th day of April 1946 by a three-fifths vote of all the members of the Council, declared that as power and authority to introduce Daylight Saving Time is inadequate, an emergency exists.

WHEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Township of Esquimalt enacts as follows:

1. That during the period of 28th day of April 1946 to the 28th day of September 1946, both of such days being inclusive, time for all purposes in the Municipality of Esquimalt shall be seven (7) hours behind Greenwich time.
2. That between the dates inclusive, set out in paragraph one hereof, all reference to time in any By-law of the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt, be read and construed as being seven hours behind Greenwich time.
3. That should any person be guilty of a breach of any By-law of the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt, in which time is a factor, the penalty for the infraction thereof so set out in any such By-law shall apply and be applicable.
4. That this By-law has been passed by a three-fifths vote of all the members of the Council.
5. That this By-law shall not come into force until approved by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council.
6. This By-law may be cited as the "DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME BY-LAW 1946".
