CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT

BY-LAW NO. 438

Being a By-law to acquire a certain area of land from Carol Victor Gilbert, Walter Benson and Joseph Downey, In Trust 154898-I and D. F. 50173, and establishing and dedicating same as forming a portion of a public highway:

WHEREAS the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt has agreed to acquire from Carol Victor Gilbert, Walter Benson and Joseph Downey, the area of land hereinafter described in Section 1, of this By-law at and for the price of one (\$1.00) dollar for the purpose of improving Admirals Road:

AND WHEREAS the purchase price of the said area of land does not require the assent of the electors of the said Corporation:

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt enacts as follows:

- 1. It shall be lawful for the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt to acquire by conveyance, from Carl Victor Gilbert, Walter Benson and Joseph Downey (In Trust 154898-I and D. F. 50173) for improving and widening Admirals Road, and establishing as a portion thereof, the area of land described as follows: All that part of Lot one hundred and fifty-eight (158) of registered Plan 2854, lying to the South East of a straight line drawn from a point in the Southerly boundary of said lot distant ten and five tenths (10.5) feet, Westerly from the South Easterly corner thereof to a point in the Easterly boundary distant fifteen and seven tenths (15.7) feet Northerly from the South-Easterly corner of said lot and containing eighty-two and four tenths (82.4) square feet more or less.
- 2. That the said area of land so described in Section 1 of this By-law on registration of title thereto in the name of the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt, be established and set aside and dedicated for use as a public highway and hereafter shall be known as forming part of Admirals Road.
- 3. This By-law may be cited as "Admirals Road Improvement By-law No. 1."

PASSED the Municipal Council on the Twenty-eight day of October, 1946.

RECONSIDERED, ADOPTED AND FINALLY PASSED the Municipal Council this Twelfth day of November, 1946.
