

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT

BY-LAW NO. 492

BEING a by-law to authorize the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt to acquire an interest in lands and premises for use as a Detention Home.

WHEREAS the Corporation of the City of Victoria, is the registered owner of Lots fourteen (14) and fifteen (15) in Parcel "A" (D.D. 40094-I) of Lot eleven (11) and Parcel "B" (D.D. 40094-I) of Lot sixteen (16), of Section seventy-five (75), Plan one thousand and forty-two (1042), Victoria District, upon which is situate premises used by the Corporation of the City of Victoria, as a Detention Home pursuant to the "Juvenile Delinquent Act, 1929".

AND WHEREAS the Corporation of the City of Victoria has offered to convey to the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt as seven-one hundredth (7 1/100) interest in the said lands and premises and to convey to the Corporations of the Districts of Oak Bay and Saanich certain interests in the said lands and premises with the purposes of the said City and surrounding Municipalities using the same as a Detention Home pursuant to the aforesaid Act.

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt deem it expedient to accept such conveyance with the view of using the said lands and premises as a Detention Home.

AND WHEREAS the consideration for the conveyance by the Corporation of the City of Victoria to the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt is the nominal sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) in respect of the said interest of such land and premises.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt enacts as follows:

1. It shall be lawful for the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt to acquire from the Corporation of the City of Victoria by a conveyance of a seven-one hundredth (7 1/100) interest in the lands and premises described as Lots fourteen (14) and fifteen (15) in Parcel "A" (D.D. 40094-I) of Lot eleven (11) and Parcel "B" (D.D. 40094-I) of Lot sixteen (16) of Section seventy-five (75), Plan 1042, Victoria District, for the purpose of using such premises as a Detention Home pursuant to the "Juvenile Delinquent Act."
2. This by-law may be cited as the "DETENTION HOME ACQUISITION BY-LAW".

PASSED by the Municipal Council on the 21st day of June, 1948.

RECONSIDERED, ADOPTED and FINALLY PASSED by the Municipal Council this 6th day of July, 1948.
