

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT

BY-LAW NO. 553

A By-Law to ratify Agreement dated the 20th day of May, 1952, between HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN in the right of the Province of British Columbia represented by The Minister of Public Works and the CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT providing for the classification of Tillicum Road as a Secondary Highway.

WHEREAS in pursuance of Section 46 (1) of the "Highway Act", Revised Statutes of British Columbia 1948, Chapter 144, an Agreement dated the 20th day of May, 1952 has been entered into between Her Majesty the Queen in the right of the Province of British Columbia represented by the Minister of Public Works and the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt providing that Tillicum Road within the limits of the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt be classified as a Secondary Highway;

AND WHEREAS the route of said Tillicum Road throughout the Municipal area of the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt has been delineated upon a map attached to the said Agreement;

AND WHEREAS Section 46 (1) of the said "Highway Act" requires that the said Agreement be ratified by By-Law of the Municipal Council of the Township of Esquimalt approving the said proposed classification and route;

NOW THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT enacts as follows:

1. The said recited Agreement dated the 20th day of May, 1952, is hereby ratified and the proposed classification of Tillicum Road within the limits of the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt as a Secondary Highway and the route thereof are hereby approved by and on behalf of the said Corporation.
2. The Reeve and Clerk are hereby authorized to formally express such ratification and approval under the Corporate Seal of the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt.
3. This By-Law may be cited as the "Highway Act Agreement Ratification By-Law 1952".

PASSED the Municipal Council on the 26th day of May, 1952.

RECONSIDERED, ADOPTED AND FINALLY PASSED the Municipal Council this 29th day of May, 1952.
