

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT

BY-LAW NO. 642

BEING a By-law to authorize the acquisition by the Corporation of certain lands and the dedication thereof as a public highway.

WHEREAS it has been agreed by and between the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt (hereinafter referred to as the "Corporation") and George H. Wheaton, Esq., that for and in consideration of the payment by the Corporation to the said George H. Wheaton, Esq., the said George H. Wheaton convey the lands hereinafter described to the Corporation in order that the same might be dedicated as and for a public highway for all purposes.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to authorize the acquisition of the said lands at and for the consideration aforesaid and to provide for the dedication of the same upon the acquisition thereof.

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

1. That the Corporation shall acquire from George H. Wheaton, Esq., at and for the price or consideration of ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00) to be paid by the Corporation to the said George H. Wheaton all and singular that certain piece or parcel of land lying, being and situate in the Municipality of Esquimalt, in the Province of British Columbia, and more particularly described as follows, that is to say:

All that part of Lot 2, Plan 6411, Section 10 and 11, Esquimalt District, lying within the following described boundaries:-
Commencing at the most southerly corner of the said Lot 2; thence northwesterly along the arc of a curve, the centre of which is 42.87 feet on a bearing of N29°08'E from the point of commencement an arc distance of 44.61 feet to a point on the westerly boundary of the said Lot 2; thence S 1°14'E along the said westerly boundary of the said Lot 2; then S60°52'E along the southwesterly boundary of the said Lot 2 24.57 feet to the point of commencement.

2. That upon the acquisition as aforesaid of the said lands the same shall be dedicated and shall be deemed to have been hereby dedicated as and for a public highway for all purposes.
3. That the Reeve and Clerk be and are hereby authorized to affix the Seal of the Corporation to a plan to accompany this By-law when the same is filed in the Land Registry Office.
4. This By-law may be cited as the "Northeasterly Corner of Fairview and Viewfield Roads Acquisition and Dedication By-law, 1955".

PASSED by the Municipal Council on the 12th day of September, A.D., 1955.

RECONSIDERED, ADOPTED AND FINALLY PASSED as aforesaid by the Municipal Council on the 26th day of September, A.D. 1955.
