

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT

BY-LAW NO. 675

BEING a by-law to define and set aside a certain area for park purposes and to authorize the laying-out and utilization of the lands comprised in such area for the purposes of a public park, to be known as "Lampson Park".

WHEREAS lands situate, lying and being in the Township of Esquimalt and described as Lot Seven (7), Plan 6644 have been acquired by the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt.

AND WHEREAS the value of the said lands does not exceed an amount equal to one dollare multiplied by the population figure according to the last deceinnial census for the Township of Esquimalt;

AND WHEREAS the said lands first became the property of the Township of Esquimalt, through tax-sale proceedings;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That the area comprising the lands situate, lying and being in the Township of Esquimalt and described as Lot 7, Plan 6644, is hereby defined and set aside for park purposes.
2. That the said lands situate, lying and being in the Township of Esquimalt and described as Lot 7, Plan 6644 shall be laid out and henceforth utilized for the purpose of a public park.
3. That the said area comprising the said lands shall henceforth be known as "Lampson Park."
4. This By-law may be cited as the "LAMPSON PARK DEFINITION BY-LAW, 1956".

PASSED by the Municipal Council by a three-fourths majority of all members thereof on the 23rd day of April, 1956.

RECONSIDERED, ADOPTED and FINALLY PASSED by the Municipal Council by a three-fourths majority of all the members thereof this 7th day of May, 1956.
