

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT

BY-LAW NO. 692

BEING a by-law to authorize the purchase by the Corporation of Part of Lot Five (5) in Section Eleven (11), Esquimalt District, Plan 5050, described as follows: that part of the said Lot Five (5) lying to the west of a line parallel and distant easterly ten feet (10') from the west boundary and north of a line parallel and distant southerly one hundred forty feet (140') from the north boundary of the said Lot Five (5).

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt enacts as follows:

1. That the Corporation shall acquire from Alexander McFarlane, of 1164 Munro Street, in the Township of Esquimalt, in the Province of British Columbia, for the price or consideration of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) in lawful money of Canada, all and singular that certain parcel or tract of land lying, being and situate in the Municipality of the Township of Esquimalt and more particularly known and described as that part of Lot Five (5) of Section Eleven (11), Esquimalt District Plan 5050, described as follows that is to say: that part of the said Lot Five (5) lying to the west of a line parallel and distant easterly ten feet (10') from the west boundary and north of a line parallel and distant southerly one hundred forty feet (140') from the north boundary of the said Lot Five (5) the same being required for the purposes of the Corporation.
2. That the Treasurer be and he is hereby authorized to pay the said sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) to the said Alexander McFarlane upon delivery to him of a good and sufficient deed in registerable form.
3. That this By-law may be cited for all purposes as "LAND ACQUISITION BY-LAW (NO. 2), 1956".

PASSED by the Municipal Council on the 10th day of September, 1956.
