CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT

BY-LAW NO. 806

BEING a By-law to authorize the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt to sell Lot 2, Block 14, Esquimalt District, Plan 2546 to Peter Cairns and Patricia Regina Cairns.

WHEREAS the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt is seized in fee simple of the lands hereinafter described,

AND WHEREAS the said lands and premises are no longer required for Municipal or other public purposes and are free from any reservation or dedication under the terms of Sections 465 and 466 of the "Municipal Act",

AND WHEREAS there are no buildings or structutes of any kind on the said land and premises,

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation has power to sell and dispose of the said lands by by-law,

AND WHEREAS the said Peter Cairns and Patricia Regina Cairns have paid to the Corporation the purchase price in the amount of \$500.00,

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT enacts as follows:

- It shall be lawful for the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt to sell, grant and convey Lot 2, Block 14, Esquimalt District, Plan 2546 for the price or sum of \$500.00 of lawful money of Canada payable by the said Peter Cairns and Patricia Regina Cairns to the Corporation in cash, reserving thereover an Easement for the purpose of establishing a sanitary sewer upon that part of Lot 2, Block 14, Esquimalt District, Plan 2546 heing a strip of land ten feet (10') wide lying five feet (5') on either side of a centre line which line runs from a point in the westerly boundary of the said Lot 2, distant five feet (5') from the south-westerly corner of the said Lot 2, distant thirty-eight feet (38') from the north-easterly corner of the said Lot 2.
- 2. The Reeve and the Municipal Clerk of the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt are hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver a deed of conveyance granting and conveying the said Lot 2, Block 14, Esquimalt District, Plan 2546 to Peter Cairns and Patricia Regina Cairns of 132 Douglas Street, Victoria, British Columbia.
- 3. This By-law may be cited as the "Iand Sale By-law (No. 18) 1958".
