

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT

BY-LAW NO. 817

BEING a By-law to repeal By-law No. 724 and to authorize an increase in the group life insurance for certain members of the Police Force of the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt.

WHEREAS By-law No. 724 of the Corporation provided for the procuring of a policy of group life insurance upon certain members of the Police Force of the Corporation,

AND WHEREAS it has been agreed that the insurance coverage provided in accordance with the said By-law No. 724 be increased,

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt enacts as follows:

1. By-law No. 724 of the Corporation is hereby repealed.
2. It shall be lawful for the Corporation to apply to the Mutual Life Assurance Company of Canada to increase the coverage provided on the existing policy of group insurance for the members of the Police Force of the Corporation who wish to avail themselves of such insurance from \$3,000.00 to \$5,000.00. The said policy of group insurance is to be effective at the figure of \$5,000.00 from the date of the said application.
3. The Corporation shall assume and pay one-third of the cost of the said insurance by paying one-third of the premiums thereon, and the payment by the Corporation of the Corporation's share of one-third of the premiums for the said insurance is hereby authorized.
4. The Municipal Clerk is hereby authorized to sign the said application and the Reeve and the Clerk are hereby authorized to sign such other documents on behalf of the Corporation as may be required to perfect the said insurance.
5. This By-law may be cited as the "Police Group Insurance By-law, 1958".
