

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT

BY-LAW NO. 861

BEING a By-Law to provide for an annuity for a retiring Police Magistrate, Henry C. Hall, Q.C.

WHEREAS Henry C. Hall, Q.C. will retire as Police and Stipendary Magistrate for the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt on the 28th day of February, A.D. 1959 having attained the age of 75 years.

AND WHEREAS under Section 660, subsection 2, of the Municipal Act the Council may, by By-Law, adopted by an affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of all the members of the said Council, grant to such Magistrate having attained the age of 75 years an annuity in accordance with the terms and conditions set out therein.

AND WHEREAS the salary of the said Henry C. Hall, Q.C. at the date of his said retirement amounted to \$780.00 per year.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT enacts as follows:

1. There shall be paid from the general revenues of the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt an annuity of \$260.00 per annum to Henry C. Hall, Q.C. for his lifetime, commencing from the 1st day of March, A.D. 1959, such annuity to be paid in equal monthly instalments in arrear, the first of such instalments to be payable upon the 31st day of March, A.D. 1959 and the subsequent instalments upon the last day of each and every calendar month during the lifetime of the said Henry C. Hall, Q.C.
2. The Reeve and the Treasurer for the time being and from time to time during the lifetime of the said Henry C. Hall are authorized to sign the cheques covering the payments aforesaid.
3. This By-Law may be cited as the "Police Magistrate Annuity By-Law 1959"
