

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT

BY-LAW NO. 92

WHEREAS under and by virtue of the Municipal Act, 1914, Chap. 52, Section 54, Subsection 164, the Council of a Municipality may make By-Laws for obtaining by referendum the opinion and vote of the Municipal electors upon any questions which affect the Municipality and for regulating the mode of so obtaining the opinion or vote of such Municipal electors:

NO THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Reeve and Council of the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt as follows:

1. At the time of holding the next annual election of the Reeve and Council the opinion of the Municipal electors shall be obtained and a vote taken of such Municipal electors to decide whether or not the Municipality shall contribute towards the support and maintenance of the public Library in the City of Victoria.

2. For the purpose of voting on such question each Municipal elector at the said election shall, in addition to the ordinary Ballot paper, be handed a further Ballot paper in words following, that is to say:

(Are you in favor of the Municipality)	
(contributing towards the support and)	Yes
(maintenance of the Public Library in)	
(the City of Victoria?)	No

3. Such Ballot paper shall be marked by the Municipal elector and afterwards be dealt with and counted in like manner as the ballots cast at the same time for the election of Councillors and Reeve.

4. An affirmative vote shall be made by placing a cross (thus X) in the upper right-hand space designated "Yes" on the Ballot paper supplied and a negative vote by placing a similar cross in the lower right-hand space designated "No".

5. That for furthering and attaining the purposes aforesaid all proper directions be given and arrangements be made.

6. This By-Law may be cited as the "Library referendum By-Law."

PASSED the Municipal Council of the Township of Esquimalt the 8th day of December, A. D. 1919.

RECONSIDERED, ADOPTED AND FINALLY PASSED the Municipal Council on the 22nd day of December, A. D. 1919.
