

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT

BY-LAW NO. 940

BEING a By-law to provide for the use for all purposes of the statutory definition of improvements for school purposes.

WHEREAS in accordance with the provisions of Section 336 of the "Municipal Act" the Council may by by-law provide that for the purposes of the "Municipal Act" the assessed values of land and improvements shall be determined pursuant to the "Assessment Equalization Act" and that thereafter such value shall be so determined in the Township of Esquimalt.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

1. That for the purposes of the "Municipal Act" the assessed values of lands and improvements within the Township of Esquimalt for the purpose of levying rates other than school rates shall be determined pursuant to the "Assessment Equalization Act" and thereafter such values shall be so determined within the Township of Esquimalt for the purposes of the "Municipal Act" and shall apply to all by-laws adopted pursuant thereto.
2. The Assessor and Collector shall make appropriate changes in the records and rolls to give proper effect to the provisions of this by-law.
3. This By-law may be cited as the "Assessment Definition By-law, 1960".

PASSED by an affirmative vote of not less than two-thirds of the Municipal Council on NOV 28 1960
