The work will require closing the E&N Rail Trail between Stancombe Place and Admirals Road. Advance warning signs advising of the closure will also be placed on the E&N Rail Trail at Maple Bank Road and at Intervale Avenue.

No pedestrians or cyclists will be allowed on the E&N Rail Trail between Stancombe Place and Admirals Road between the hours of 9:00 am and 3:00 pm.

Traffic control devices, such as, but not limited to, signage and delineators, will be used to close off the area and detour pedestrians and cyclists.

The plan will require the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt to advise B.C. Transit that B.C. Transit Stop Id 100691, Admirals Road at Coles Street (southbound), will need to be closed during working hours to maintain cyclists' safety.

The plan may require the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt to remove parking on the east side of Admirals Road just north of Stancombe Place to just south of Coles Street.

A speed reduction to thirty (30) kilometers per hour will be put in place northbound on Admirals Road prior to Coles Street and southbound on Admirals Road prior to Stancombe Place.

Both the northbound and southbound bike lanes of Admirals Road will be coned off from Coles Street to Colville Road. Cones will be placed +/- ten (10) meters apart.

Four (4) certified traffic control personnel (TCPs) will be positioned to assist pedestrians and cyclists:

1. One (1) TCP on the E&N Rail Trail at the Stancombe Place detour
2. One (1) TCP at the trail closure at Colville Road
3. One (1) TCP at the Admirals Road – Cole Street intersection/detour
4. One (1) TCP positioned at the pedestrian island on the east side of the Admirals Road – Colville Road intersection

Eastbound

The E&N Rail Trail will be closed at Stancombe Place.

Pedestrians and cyclists will exit the E&N Rail Trail onto Stancombe Place, turn right south onto Admirals Road: pedestrians will use the sidewalk while cyclists will use the existing bike lane.

Westbound

The E&N Rail Trail will be closed at Admirals Road.

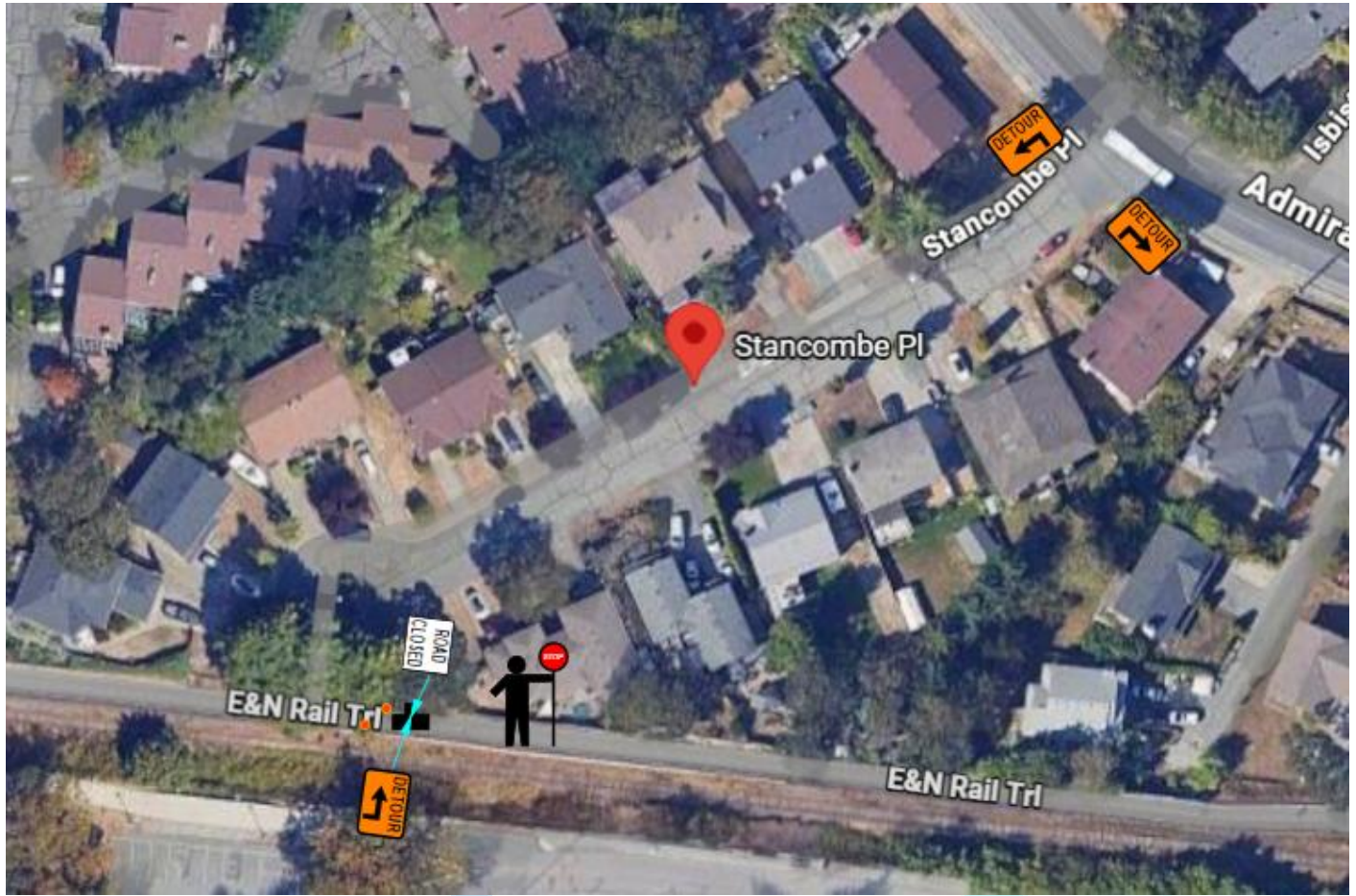
Pedestrians

Will travel north on Admirals Road to access Stancombe Place to return to the E&N Rail Trail.

Cyclists

Will travel north on Admirals Road in the existing bike lane to Cole Street. At Cole Street they will use the signalized marked pedestrian east – west crosswalk to cross to the west side of Admirals Road where they will enter a dedicated delineated temporary bike lane. They will then turn left/west at Stancombe Place to return to the E&N Rail Trail.

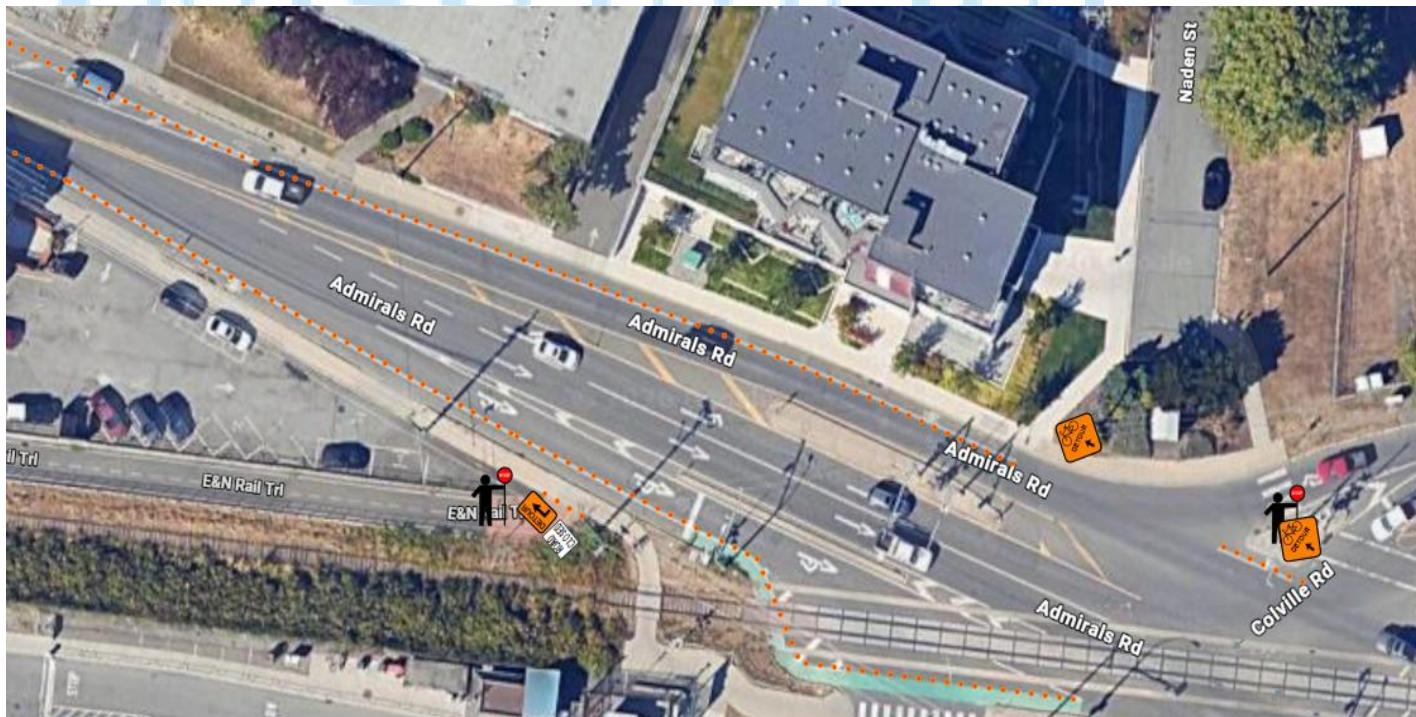
