FIREWORKS

- The personal possession and use of fireworks in the Township of Esquimalt is strictly prohibited and may result in a penalty or fine.
- Permits may be issued to community groups under special circumstances.

OUTDOOR BURNING

- Outdoor open air burning of any kind is not allowed in public spaces without a permit.
- Private residential burning that uses propane, natural gas, or charcoal briquettes is permitted without a permit provided that it sits on a firm noncombustible base.
