

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT

BY-LAW NO. 506

BEING a By-Law to authorize the construction of a sewer for a distance of 657.4 feet, having a sectional area of less than four feet, along a road known as Bryden Court, and to connect same to existing common sewer on Head Street, as a Local Improvement under the provisions of the "Local Improvement Act".

WHEREAS the owners of Lots sixteen (16) to twenty-eight (28), inclusive, Esquimalt District, Map 5646, have petitioned the Council to construct as a local improvement the work hereinafter described, and the Clerk has certified that the petition is sufficient and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the petition in the manner hereinafter provided.

AND WHEREAS the work proposed is the construction of a sewer and the total cost of the work is to be specially assessed upon the same lots equally bordering on and to be served by such sewer, and the Superintendent of Works of the Corporation has duly caused plans and particulars to be furnished the Council for the making of a contract for the execution of the work.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt enacts as follows:

1. That a sewer of vitrified pipe having a sectional area of under four (4') feet be constructed as a local improvement, under the provisions of the "Local Improvement Act" on Bryden Court Road, through Lots sixteen (16) of said Plan 5646, and Parcel "A" of Lot fifteen (15), Block 3, Map 195, to Head Street, having a total length of 657.4 feet, with private drain connections on Bryden Court Road, connecting such sewer with the lots specified in Schedule 1.
2. That the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt is authorized to proceed with the construction of the work under the superintendence and according to the directions of the Superintendent of Works.
3. That the Treasurer may (subject to the approval of the Council) agree with any bank or person for temporary advances of money to meet the cost of the work pending the completion of it.
4. The special assessment shall be by twenty annual instalments, this period being within the estimated lifetime of the work, and each of such lots, namely, Lots sixteen (16) to twenty-eight (28), inclusive, Esquimalt District, Plan 5646, are to be assessed equally, and without regard to frontage space or area.

5. The Superintendent of Works has made a report to the Council reporting the entire work has been accomplished by the Corporation, at a cost of \$3,276.00.

6. The debentures, to be issued for the loan to be effected to pay for the cost of the work so completed, shall bear interest at 3½ per centum per annum, and be made payable within twenty years on a serial debenture issue.

7. This By-Law shall be known and cited for all purposes as the "Bryden Court Sewer, Local Improvement Construction By-Law, 1949".

PASSED the Municipal Council on the 28th day of March, 1949.

RECONSIDERED, ADOPTED AND FINALLY PASSED the Municipal Council this 11th day of April, 1949.
