

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT

BY-LAW NO. 1200

BEING a By-law to provide for the numbering
of buildings within the Township of Esquimalt.

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
ESQUIMALT, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. The Building Inspector is hereby authorized, to number, re-number, or alter the number of all buildings of any kind, including those already numbered as, in his discretion, he may deem expedient.
2. Upon the issuing of a Building Permit, the Building Inspector shall designate the number or series of numbers requisite for the building authorized by such permit, and it shall be the duty of the owner to place the designated number or numbers upon the building in a conspicuous position, and of such size as to be plainly visible from the street. If the owner fails to number such building, the Building Inspector is authorized to place such number or numbers upon the building, and the cost of such numbering shall be recoverable from the said owner.
3. Any person failing to comply with the provisions of this By-law or failing to comply with any lawful direction given hereunder by the Building Inspector, shall be guilty of an offence, and shall be liable upon summary conviction to a fine not exceeding \$25.00.
4. This By-law may be cited as the "Building Numbering By-law, 1967".
