

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT

BY-LAW NO. 1185

BEING a By-law to dedicate as a highway the westerly five feet of Lots 163, 164 and 165 of Suburban Lot 43, Esquimalt District, Plan 2854.

WHEREAS the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt has acquired the above lands for purposes of a highway;

AND WHEREAS under the "Land Registry Act" R.S.B.C. 1960, Chapter 208, the Municipal Council is required to dedicate the lands described as all that certain parcel or tract of land lying and being in

the Township of Esquimalt, in the Province of British Columbia and being more particularly known and described as those parts of Lots 163, 164 and 165 of Suburban Lot 43, Esquimalt District, Plan 2854, lying to the west of a boundary parallel to and perpendicularly distant five feet from the westerly boundaries of said lots, for the purpose of a highway in order to have title thereto included within the boundaries of a plan of subdivision of Lots 163, 164 and 165 and Part 221 of Suburban Lot 43, Esquimalt District, Plan 2854, as such plan of subdivision has been prepared by H. Hill of the City of Victoria, in the Province of British Columbia, British Columbia Land Surveyor, and sworn by the said H. Hill as of the 19th day of May, 1966;

AND WHEREAS the said lands comprise an area of less than one (1) acre;

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. Pursuant to the powers contained in Section 468 (2) of the Municipal Act" R.S.B.C. 1960, Chapter 255 and amending Acts, all that certain parcel or tract of land lying and being in the Township of Esquimalt, in the Province of British Columbia and being more particularly known and described as those parts of Lots 163, 164 and 165 of Suburban lot 43, Esquimalt District, Plan 2854, lying to the west of a boundary parallel to and perpendicularly distant five feet from the westerly boundaries of said lots, shall be and the same is hereby dedicated as a highway to become a part of the highway known as Admirals Road.
2. This By-law may be cited as the "Highway Dedication By-law, 1966."
