

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT

BY-LAW NO. 89

WHEREAS the Council of the said Corporation is by the "Municipal Act" Section 54, Subsection 166, authorized by By-law to exempt improvements from taxation entirely;

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township enacts as follows:

1. That all improvements within the Municipal limits of the Township of Esquimalt shall be entirely exempt from taxation.
2. That this By-law is subject to the provisions and restrictions in the "Municipal Act" and "Amendment Acts" and the expression "improvements" shall, in this By-law, have the meaning conferred thereon by the "Municipal Act."
3. This By-law shall not be construed so as to exempt from taxation any classes of property which are by the "Municipal Act" or "Amending Acts" expressly declared to be deemed to be land for the purposes of assessment and taxation.
4. This By-law may be cited as the "IMPROVEMENTS EXEMPTION BY-LAW 1919".
