#### **INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS**

Quotes will only be considered when properly submitted on the official Form of Tender. All submissions are required to be emailed as a PDF attachment to <a href="mailto:neal.widdifield@esquimalt.ca">neal.widdifield@esquimalt.ca</a>, with subject line identified as "ITQ No. FR 25-01 – SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF – ONE (1) HALF TON HYBRID PICKUP TRUCK" before 2:00 PM (PST), August 15, 2025.

<u>Please Note</u>: Email submissions could be delayed or rejected by the Township of Esquimalt's email security system. The onus is on the tenderers to make sure the Township receives the email submission.

**Maximum** email submission size is 35 MB. If email submission is larger than 35 MB, please submit in multiple emails.

- Tender hardcopies will <u>Not</u> be accepted. Quotes may be revised by email, provided that any revisions concerning financial consideration must state only the amount by which a figure is to be increased or decreased, and not any new revised totals. Revisions must be received prior to 1:45 PM, August 15, 2025 to <u>neal.widdifield@esquimalt.ca</u>. Respondents assume <u>ALL</u> responsibilities for email submission.
- 3. The price quoted shall be in Canadian Funds and will include all and every cost, including tax. Pricing shall be held firm for a period of 90 (NINETY) days.
- 4. The bidder may submit equipment literature with the tender. This literature will be viewed as background information only and does not form part of the completion of the specifications evaluation criteria. In order for equipment information to be reviewed and evaluated the bidder must complete the specification sheet of the tender.
- 5. The specifications for this equipment are minimum specifications. Any additions or variations from the minimum specifications must be noted.
- 6. Evaluation Criteria
  - 6.1. The evaluation of the tender will be carried out by a weighted evaluation strategy.

    The lowest priced tender may not be the successful bid in the process. The following criteria outlined below will be utilized in the evaluation of the tender.
  - 6.1.1. Cost 45%
    Specifications 30%
    Delivery 15%
    Local Servicing 5%
    Warranty 5%



- 6.2. The following paragraphs provide a brief description for the above criteria to assist the Bidder in providing the information that is expected by the Township.
- 6.2.1. **Cost** Quotes will be evaluated on their own and in comparison to the allocated budget amount and each other.
- 6.2.2. **Specifications** The Bidder shall complete every space in **SECTION 2 BIDDER'S RESPONSE** column with either a check mark (√□) in the Yes box to indicate the item being bid meets the specification or a check mark (√□) in the No box and a description to indicate any deviation of item being bid from the specifications, any deviations from these specifications which, in the opinion of the Township do not affect the overall requirements of the unit may be considered. Dealer supplied or installed components must be noted in the right hand column.
- 6.2.3. **Delivery** The bidder is to assume that the notice of award of the tender should be on or before **August 29, 2025** and provide a delivery schedule from this point.
  - 6.2.3.1. **FOB POINT** Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt, Esquimalt Fire Rescue Services 101-1151 Esquimalt Road, Esquimalt BC.
- 6.2.4. **Local Servicing** The vendor must be fully authorized by the manufacturer to sell, service, and provide <u>warranty</u> support for the proposed equipment. The vendor must identify where servicing is to be provided. Down time of equipment is to be minimized, therefore a preference is for local servicing. The Township of Esquimalt mechanics shop and personnel are to be designated as a warranty depot for minor repairs. Indicate, in the space provided in the Specifications under Warranties, details on the type of repairs that can be done within the Township's shop.
- 6.2.5. **Warranty** Bids must clearly show warranty and/or guarantee for the equipment. Any repairs or service in conjunction with the warranty and or guarantee shall be at no cost to the Township of Esquimalt. There will be no additional costs for freight or technician travel time.
- 7. The Municipality of Esquimalt reserves the right to refuse acceptance of any vehicle damaged prior to FOB delivery point.
- 8. Acceptance & Rejection of Tenders

Notwithstanding any custom in the trade, the owner reserves the full right to, in its sole discretion and according to its own judgement and best interest:

- 8.1. Reject any and/or all quotes.
- 8.2. Waive any minor technical or formal defect in a tender and accept that tender.
- 8.3. Award the contract to other than the lowest bidder.
- 8.4. To accept any quote.
- 8.5. To reject any and/or all irregularities in the tenders submitted.



- 8.6. To make decisions with due regard to quality of service, experience, compliance with requirements and any other such factors as may be necessary in the circumstances.
- 8.7. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, any quote may be disqualified or rejected which is incomplete, obscure or irregular, which has erasures or corrections in the Form of Tender, in which prices are omitted or are unbalanced.
- 8.8. To reject any and/or all tenders that exceeds the budget for this equipment.
- 8.9. To cancel or reissue the tender without any changes, in the event that only one compliant response is received, and/or if the fees submitted exceed the estimated budget for this project.
- 8.10. To accept or reject any trade-in allowances.

#### 9. Cancellation

The Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt reserves the right to cancel this process at any time and for any reason, and will not be responsible for any loss, damage, cost or expense incurred or suffered by any bidder as a result of that cancellation.

#### 10. Conflict of Interest

The Bidder warrants that the Bidder is not employed by the Township, nor is an immediate relative of such an employee, if the goods or services to be supplied under this Tender are intended to be supplied to the department in which such employee works.

If the Bidder is a company, the Bidder warrants that none of its officers, directors or employees with authority to bind the company are employees of the Township or immediate relatives of employees of the Township, if the goods or services to be supplied under this Tender are intended to be supplied to the department in which such employee works.

In this section "Immediate Relative" means a spouse, parent, child, brother, sister, brother-in-law, or sister-in-law of a municipal employee.

#### 11. Solicitation

If any director, officer, employee, agent or other representative of a Bidder makes any representation or solicitation to the Mayor, any Councillor, officer or employee of the Corporation with respect to the Quote, whether before or after the submission of the Tender, the Corporation shall be entitled to not accept the Tender.



#### 12. Disclaimer

Bidders responding to this competitive process agree to the terms and conditions of the bid opportunity as issued by the Township of Esquimalt. Submissions shall not contain any alterations to the posted document other than entering data in the spaces provided or including attachments as necessary. Bidders who alter the document as issued may be disqualified from this competition.

#### 13. No Claim for Compensation

Except as expressly and specifically permitted in these Instructions to Bidders, no Tender shall have any claim for any compensation of any kind whatsoever, as a result of participating in the tender, and by submitting a bid each bidder shall be deemed to have agreed that it has no claim.

#### 14. Agreement on Internal Trade / Tilma

This procurement may be covered by the <u>Agreement on Internal Trade, Annex 502.4</u> - Procurement ("AIT") and by the NWPTA.

#### 15. Addenda

Any and all addendums to this bid opportunity will be posted on our website at <a href="https://www.esquimalt.ca">www.esquimalt.ca</a>, and BC Bid at <a href="https://www.bcbid.gov.bc.ca">www.bcbid.gov.bc.ca</a>. It is the sole responsibility of participants to make sure that they are in receipt of all addendums prior to the tender closing.

The Township of Esquimalt will not issue addenda less than three (3) days prior to the closing date without a corresponding reasonable extension of the closing date.

#### 16. Form of Tender

- 16.1. Each bidder shall state in the space provided on the Form of Tender, the receipt and inclusion of Addenda issued prior to the Tender closing.
- 16.2. Failure to include all Addenda issued may render the Tender invalid.

#### 17. Clarification of Contract Documents

- 17.1. The bidder must carefully examine the Tender documents. Should a bidder find discrepancies in, or omissions from the document or specifications, or should the bidder be in doubt as to their meaning, the bidder should at once notify the Township of Assistant Fire Chief Neal Widdifield in writing. The bidder may not claim, after the submission of a Tender, that there was any misunderstanding with respect to the conditions imposed by the documents.
- 17.2. No claim by the bidder of unsuitability or unavailability of material will be accepted unless submitted in writing at least **THREE** (3) calendar days before the Tender closing date, and approval by the owner is granted, prior to Tender closing.
- 17.3. Written Addenda will be issued to amend the Tender documents if required.



17.4. No verbal agreement or conversation made or had at any time with any officer, agency or employee of the Owner shall affect or modify any of the terms or obligations herein stated.
