# **POSITION FUNCTION**

Perform manual labouring functions on a variety of projects.

## **KEY DUTIES**

Perform various manual tasks such as loading trucks, setting up traffic and pedestrian control signs and directing traffic; form, screed and finish concrete; break and lay asphalt; dig trenches; lay sewer pipes; lift and place castings and pipes; assist painter and electrical worker as required.

Use a variety of hand tools and power equipment such as compressor, jackhammer, cement mixer, drills, concrete cut off saw, tamper, and pipe cutter.

Perform related duties where qualified.

## INDEPENDENCE

Work is assigned by supervisor.

Work is reviewed while in progress by supervisor.

Problems involving deviations from established procedures are referred to supervisor.

## WORKING CONDITIONS

## Physical effort:

Lift and move heavy materials and equipment. (continuous)

Mental effort:

Normal.

## Visual/auditory effort:

Normal.

## Work environment:

Outdoors.

Work in close proximity to heavy moving equipment and traffic; work in confined space. (frequent)
