

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT

BY-LAW NO. 337

BEING a By-law renaming part of Armit  
Road as Munro Street.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt deem it expedient to alter the name of "Armit" Road in so far as it applies to the said road from Fraser Street to the present western terminus of Munro Street.

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Esquimalt therefore enacts as follows:

1. The name "Armit" be changed to "Munro" in so far as it relates or refers to the name of the street from Fraser Street to the present western terminus of Munro Street and that hereafter the street or road from Fraser Street to Anson Street be known and designated as Munro Street.
2. This By-law may be cited as the "MUNRO STREET RENAMING BY-LAW".

PASSED the Municipal Council on the 29th day of September, 1941.
