CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT

BY-LAW NO. 1066

BEING a By-law for the subdivision of land and dedication and establishment of certain highways in the Rockheights Subdivision.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council is empowered in accordance with the provisions of Section 468 and Section 513 of the "Municipal Act" of the Province of British Columbia to establish and to dedicate highways within the Municipality,

AND WHEREAS the Council has caused to be prepared a plan of subdivision of Part of Lot 20, Block 1, Plan 913 in Section 10, Esquimalt District, B.C., which plan of subdivision was prepared by P.D. Williams, B.C.L.S., of the City of Victoria, in the Province of British Columbia, and sworn to by the said P.D. Williams on the 18th day of October, 1963.

AND WHEREAS there appear upon the said plan certain areas allotted therein for public highways and described thereon as Matheson Avenue and Matheson Place.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ESQUIMALT, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. The subdivision of Part of Lot 20, Block 1, Plan 913 in Section 10, Esquimalt District, B.C., in accordance with the plan of subdivision herein described is hereby authorized.
- 2. The areas shown upon that certain plan to be submitted to the Land Registry Office at the City of Victoria, in the Province of British Columbia, and referred to herein as having been prepared by P.D. Williams, B.C.L.S. and sworn to by the said P.D. Williams upon the 18th day of October, 1963, described on the said plan as Matheson Avenue and Matheson Place, are hereby dedicated and established as public highways and shall hereafter have the names set forth upon the said plan.
- 3. It shall be lawful for the Reeve and the Clerk to execute the said plan and affix the seal of the Corporation thereto and deposit the said plan in the Land Registry Office in the City of Victoria, in the Province of British Columbia.
- 4. This By-law may be cited as the "Rockheights Subdivision and Highway Naming and Dedication By-law, 1963, (No. 2)."
