




Volunteer Accident Insurance Volunteer Accident Insurance

Volunteers are a vital part of our community. At the Municipal Insurance Association of British Columbia, we feel that volunteers should not have to put themselves at risk while volunteering. Our Volunteer Accidental Benefit Coverage Program provides first party accident coverage to local government volunteers should they be injured while delivering services to the community.

Coverage under this plan is limited to those under age 85. (under 65 with respect to Permanent Total Disability benefit and Weekly Accident Indemnity benefit). Volunteer Firefighters are excluded from this coverage.

Volunteers of MIABC members are entitled to benefits if injured while performing their volunteer duties.



WHAT COVERAGE IS PROVIDED?	
Accidental Death	\$50,000
Loss of Use Benefits	Up to \$50,000 depending on the nature of the disabling accident. (i.e. loss of use of eye, legs, quadriplegic, paraplegic).
Weekly Accident Indemnity Benefits	a) Employed persons: \$300 per week for 52 weeks for total disability; \$150 per week for 26 weeks for partial disability. b) Unemployed persons: \$100 per week for 52 weeks for total disability; \$50 per week for 26 weeks for partial disability.
