Returning Mail Ballot:	You are responsible for ensuring that your completed ballot is received by the Chief Election Officer no later than 8:00 p.m. on General Voting Day, Saturday, October 17, 2026. Mail ballots may be returned by regular mail or delivered to the address noted above. Mail ballots may also be hand delivered to the official polling station on General Voting Day between 8:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.
