The *Contract Documents* include the Drawings listed in Schedule 2 to the Agreement, entitled "List of Drawings".
- 2.2 A portion of the Contract Documents are included by reference. Copies of these documents have not been included with the tender package. These documents are the Instructions to Tender Part II, General Conditions, Specifications and Standard Detail Drawings. They are those contained in the publication entitled "Master Municipal Construction Documents General Conditions, Specifications

and Standard Detail Drawings". Refer to Schedule 1 to the Agreement or, if not specified in Schedule 1, refer to GC 2.3.1, for the correct edition of this publication applicable to this *Contract*. All sections of this publication are by reference included in the *Contract Documents*.

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Additional Instructions to Tender

4.1 Non Mandatory Site Visit:

10:00 am May 12, 2017 Esquimalt Recreation Centre parking lot, 527 Fraser Street Victoria BC. Interested parties are strongly advised to attend the meeting to gain familiarity with the project.

4.2 **Scope of Work**

- Install construction signage and site fencing. Lift and stock pile concrete wheel stops and no post barriers and re-install after paving. Supply and install riser rings for 2 manholes and a water service box. Keep work area tidy throughout and at finish of work.
- Mill alligatored asphalt and perimeter areas 38 mm deep. Load and haul material off-site. Prime and base coat milled areas with hot mix asphalt flush to surrounding asphalt. Level course low areas with hot mix asphalt
- Supply, lay and compact hot mix asphalt 38 mm finished, by machine
- Paint lines and a new crosswalk

4.3 Schedule of Work

This project shall be completed between June 21, 2017 and June 30, 2017.

4.4 Evaluation Criteria

This tender shall be awarded on a weighted evaluation criterion.

The criterion is as follows:

- Tender price 60%
- Schedule of Work 25%
- Capacity and Experience of the Company and Team 15%

Bidders shall supply information to show that the Bidder has a proven ability to manage and complete all aspects of the Work and a track record of completing the work on time. Description of projects should include information on the Bidders ability to carry out asphalt paving and line marking.
