**Public Notice** is given to the electors of the Township of Esquimalt that General Local Election will be held on **Saturday, October 20, 2018**. Nominations for the offices of:

Councillor (Six [6] to be elected)

for a four year term commencing November 2018 will be received by the Chief Election Officer or a designated person, as follows:

Nomination documents are now available at the Esquimalt Municipal Hall during regular office hours, Monday through Friday (except statutory holidays), 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. until the close of the nomination period (4:00 p.m. on September 14<sup>th</sup>, 2018).

### QUALIFICATIONS FOR OFFICE

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected, and to hold office as a member of local government if they meet the following criteria:

- Canadian citizen;
- 18 years of age or older on general voting day (October 20, 2018);
- resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed; and
- not disqualified by the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from being nominated for, being elected to, or holding the office, or be otherwise disqualified by law.

### CAMPAIGN PERIOD EXPENSE LIMITS

In accordance with the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*, for the 2018 General Local Election, the following expense limits for candidates during the campaign period apply:

- Office of Mayor \$16,044.45
- Office of Councillor \$ 8,031.72

### THIRD PARTY ADVERTISING LIMITS

In accordance with the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*, for the 2018 General Local Election, the following third party advertising limits apply:

- Office of Councillor \$802.22
