Core Service Areas


- Maintain, upgrade or construction of municipal infrastructure (linear, vertical, mobile) to current levels of service/funding

- Total FTE = 28 (26 regular, 2 temp)
- Capital Budget = \$5,905,383 (includes ETS costs)
- Operating Revenue = \$403,594
- Operating Budget = \$4,128,099
