# 5. PRESENTATION

(1) 2010 Property Tax Options – Power Point Presentation by Director of Financial Services

Director of Financial Services Robin Middleton presented the property tax options for both 4.54% tax revenue increase and 3.90% increase.

Discussion was held on the Director of Financial Services providing a comparison of the industrial tax rate.

Discussion was held regarding the capital project reserve balance.

Director Middleton provided a recap from the March 29<sup>th</sup>, 2010 Budget Meeting.

Discussion ensued on the impacts of the seven options to the working capital reserve fund and Class 4.

Chief Administrative Officer Laurie Hurst advised that in 2002/2003 \$400,000 was set aside in the working capital reserve fund as a contingency should there be an unanticipated decrease in the PILT revenues [payment in lieu of taxes].

<u>Moved</u> by Councillor McIldoon, seconded by Councillor Brame that Council direct staff to calculate property tax rates based on Option 4.

The motion **CARRIED** with Acting Mayor Linge, Councillors McIldoon, Brame, Gaul In Favour and Councillors Hundleby, Garrison Opposed.
