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## **RECOMMENDATION:**

That the application for a Development Variance Permit authorizing the construction shown on the attached site plan stamped "Received November 22, 2010", and including the following variance, at Lot 1 Section 11 Esquimalt District Plan 29010 [630 Head Street] be forwarded to Council with a **recommendation of approval**, subject to appropriate notification and a variance hearing being held.

**Zoning Bylaw 1992, No. 2050, Section 44(5)(a)** – <u>Lot Coverage</u> – a five percent (5%) increase to the thirty percent (30%) lot coverage limit for all Principle Buildings, Accessory Buildings and Structures, ie. from 30% to 35%.
